

Trail Etiquette

- Do not walk or snowshoe on trails.
- Please, **no dogs** on ski trails.
- Give the right-of-way to skiers coming downhill.
- When faster skiers shout “track”, step aside and let them pass.
- If you stop or fall, move quickly off the trail for others to pass.
- Leave a safe trail; fill in holes made by falls; remove fallen branches; etc.
- Don’t litter; carry out what you bring in.
